**SCHEDULE LP-2 -- Large Power Service
50 KW Minimum**

AVAILABILITY

Available to consumers located on or near the Cooperative's three-phase lines for all types of usage, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Three-phase, 60 hertz, at Cooperative's standard voltages.

MONTHLY RATE

Customer Charge:	@	\$40.00 per month
Demand Charge:		
All KW of Billing Demand	@	\$5.25 per KW
Energy Charge:		
All KWh	@	3.604 ¢ per KWh

Plus an adjustment per KWh of energy sold per Schedule PCRF.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as follows:

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

Demand charges may be adjusted for any consumer with actual power factor lower than ninety percent (90%). The billing demand will be computed by multiplying the measured demand by the product of ninety percent (90%) power factor, divided by the measured power factor.

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MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the higher one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question:

1. The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service.
2. A charge of \$40.00 plus \$1.00 per KVA over 50 KVA.

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGE FOR SEASONAL SERVICE

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10hp) must be three-phase.
2. All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
3. If service is furnished at the Cooperative's primary distribution voltage (consumer furnishes and maintains all transformation), a two percent (2%) discount shall apply to the above rate schedule providing the billing demand exceeds 300 KW. Monthly charges to be same as above except no transformer charge are billed.

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LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

The above rates are net. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within sixteen (16) days of mailing date, a five percent (5%) penalty will be added to bill. If the due date falls on a holiday or weekend, the due date for payment purposes shall be the next work day after the due date.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are total; bills become delinquent if unpaid sixteen (16) days after issuance (postmarked date). If the due date falls on a holiday or weekend, the due date for payment purposes shall be the next work day after the due date. Service shall be disconnected if the bill has not been paid within twenty-six (26) days from date of issuance providing proper notice has been given at least ten (10) days prior to the stated date of disconnection.

EFFECTIVE DATE

Rate to be effective upon approval of tariff by the Board of Directors of Bowie-Cass Electric Cooperative, Inc.
